#### Weekly Bible Reflections

"Brothers and sisters, whether you eat or drink, or whatever you do, do everything for the glory of God." (1 Corinthians 10:31)

Do a quick check of your priorities. Where does God rank in that list? If He's not first, you have some work to do. Putting God first in everything helps us from putting other "gods" (like our pride, ego, money and possessions) before God. Before making a decision, ask yourself, "I'm I going this for the glory of God or for the glory of me?"



#### **Eucaristic Revival Scripture Study & Soup Supper**

Join us on Wednesday evenings from 6-8pm at the PAC for a soup supper and Lenten study, from February 21 through March 20.

Liturgy is an essential element of Scripture. It is central to the Bible's story - and not just the New Testament. The New Testament



liturgy, especially the Eucharist, was promised in the Old Testament. What was anticipated, prefigured, and foreshadowed before Christ, he fulfilled in his Sacred Passion. It invites us to ask ourselves: Are we willing to extend our hands and hearts, even if it means crossing the boundaries of our comfort zones?

In what ways do you encounter "lepers" in your daily life, those marginalized or excluded by society? How can you extend Christ-like compassion to them?

What boundaries might you be called to cross to show God's love to others? How can you contribute to or seek healing within your community or church?
